If you would enjoy visiting different pubs with fine ales in friendly convivial company without the constraints of the car, then our varied programme of regular daytime 'Bus to the Pub' (BTTP) socials may just appeal !

Friday 15 April : Mid Sussex Explorer 'BTTP' to Forest Row & Lindfield

Either, meet Old Steine Brighton (Stop D) for the 10.10 Countryliner 40 x to Hay Heath PRH, or at Perrymount Road stop adj. Hay. Heath Stn. For the 11.12 Metrobus 270 to Swan, Forest Row

Wednesday 27 April (note date change): 'BTTP' Sussex POTY survey to Maypole, Yapton (GBG)

10.57 Stagecoach 700 from Worthing Pier to Yapton, Sparks Corner

Friday 6 May : West Sussex Explorer 'BTTP' to Byworth, then Tillington & Halfway Bridge area

11.00 Stagecoach 1 from South Street Worthing to Black Horse (GBG)

Tuesday 10 May : Mid Sussex Explorer 'BTTP' to Eastbourne for the South Street Shuffle

10.40 B & H 12 from Churchill Square or meet at Eastbourne Station at noon

Friday 20 May : West Sussex Explorer 'BTTP' to remote Wineham and the charming rustic Royal Oak

Either 10.28 Metrobus 23 from Worthing Pier to Southwater then pick up Metrobus 86 (11.12 from Horsham bus stn.) to Wineham Lane for short walk to pub, or 10.45 Metrobus 273 from Churchill Sq. to Hickstead and then 3.5 km lane & footpath walk with Mike Jacomb to pub

Sunday 22 May : Mid Sussex Explorer 'BTTP' with a difference to Lewes Preserved Bus Rally with a choice of routes and pubs

10.05 B & H 28 from Churchill Square to Lewes

Tuesday 31 May : 'BTTP' Sussex POTY survey to Sportsman, Amberley

10.28 Metrobus 23 from Worthing Pier to Washington then Compass 100 (starts 10.03 from Burgess Hill) to Pulborough, Swan Corner for 11.26 Compass 73 to pub.

Tuesday 7 June : 'BTTP' Sussex POTY surveys; meet from 1pm at Evening Star, Brighton (GBG) then

15.52 train to Polegate using Group Save ticket (£3.60 if 4 travel together) for bus to Kings Head, Hailsham (GBG) then return to Swan, Falmer

Tuesday 14 June : Mid Sussex Explorer 'BTTP' to Isfield and Ringmer

10.45 B & H 29 from Churchill Square (11.20 from Lewes bus stn.) to Laughing Fish, then Cock (GBG)

Saturday 25 June: West Sussex Explorer 'BTTP' to rural Graffham

10.00 Stagecoach 1 from South Street Worthing to Petworth for 11.30 Compass 99 to Forrester's then short walk onto White Horse (GBG) beer festival Anyone preferring to travel by train to Chichester can get the 12.15 99 from West Street to Graffham NB. as the 99 is a 'demand responsive' service, we have to book at least a week in advance so let Stuart know if you intend to join us

Monday 27 June : 'BTTP' Ale Trail Explorer meet Mike at Churchill Square 11, then onwards !

Friday 8 July Mid Sussex Explorer 'BTTP' to Poynings and Partridge Green 11.10 Countryliner 40x from Churchill Square to Stone Pound then 11.47 Hurst Community Bus to Royal Oak and on to the Partridge (Dark Star)

Wednesday 13 July : Either 10.28 Metrobus 23 from Worthing Pier (or 10.00 Stagecoach 17 from Brighton or 10.10 Metrobus 86 From Hay Heath PRH) to Horsham bus stn then 11.49 Metrobus 93 to Kingsfold then a pleasant approx. 30 min walk across fields to pub.

Tuesday 19 July : West Sussex Explorer 'BTTP' to Halnaker & East Ashling Either, 10.23 Compass 84 from Worthing Pier to Chichester, or by train to meet West Street then 11.45 Stagecoach 55 to Anglesey Arms (GBG) then onto Horse & Groom (GBG)

Tuesday 26 July : East Sussex Explorer 'BTTP' to the tranquil Cuckmere Valley : Either, 10.40 B & H 12 from Churchill Square to Seaford, or by train to meet at Library to pick up the 11.45 CV Ramblerbus to the Plough & Harrow, Littlington (GBG)

Friday 5 August : 'BTTP' Ale Trail Explorer to Lewes 11.00 B & H 29 from Churchill Square to Lewes Bus stn and then Snowdrop (GBG) and others

Friday 12 August : West Sussex Explorer 'BTTP' to White Horse, Maplehurst Either 10.28 Metrobus 23 from Worthing Pier to Southwater then pick up Metrobus 86 (11.12 from Horsham bus stn.) to Downs Link Trail and walk to pub, or 11.00 Stagecoach 17 from Churchill Sq. to the Crabtree and then footpath & road walk with Mike Jacomb to pub. Possible return via Partridge, Partridge Green (Dark Star)

Tuesday 16 August : 'BTTP' Ale Trail Explorer 10.35 Countryliner 40 from Churchill Square to Talbot, Cuckfield then Stand Up, Lindfield (GBG)
